  - Prophecies made by Jesus concerning the state of Israel and the Jewish people (i.e. an entire nation dispersed in 70 AD only to re-emerge as a nation after the horrors of WWII?)
  - The Jewish people's survival alone is a great apologetic for the reliability of the Bible

Many Christian apologists base the number of New Testament manuscripts on the work of Kurt Aland and Barbara Aland of the Institute for New Testament Textual Research in Münster.<sup>1</sup>

It appears there has been discovered a portion of a Mark manuscript, ca 85-125AD. One must wait for this discovery to go through peer review and publishing before we know for certain of the dating.
